

PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Fridays from 7:30 am to 7:00 pm during Lent, followed by the Stations of the Cross. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 11:45 am. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their first child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for the children of registered families of the Parish. Grades 1-7 (families only): Monday or Tuesday from 6:00 - 8:00 pm once monthly. Online Giving

Tithe.ly is our new Parish online giving system. There are three ways to give through Tithe.ly:

- through our website
- through our Facebook page
- using the Tithe.ly mobile giving App.

When giving through Tithe.ly you can donate by credit/debit card or bank transfer. You can also select "reoccurring gift" to automate your regular weekly offering so that it is donated automatically on a schedule that you choose. As with any automated service there is a small transaction fee for the church, you have the option to select "cover the fee" to make this transaction fee a part of your tax deductible gift.

If you need a Mass card for a loved one you can pay for it through Tithe.ly and email the Mass request to the parish secretary and she will schedule and send you the Mass card.
