

#### PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office. **Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament:** Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office.

**Sacrament of Baptism:** The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

*Sacrament of Marriage:* Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

*Sacrament of Reconciliation:* The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday form 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

*Sacrament of the Sick:* Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

**Sponsor Eligibility:** Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

#### WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy Communion and Confirmation. "And Jesus said to him, 'Go your way; your faith has made you well.' And immediately he received his sight and followed him on the way." (Mark 10:52)

#### Overview of the Mass continued...

#### The Penitential Act

At the beginning of Mass, after Father greets everyone is the **Penitential Act** in which we ask forgiveness for our venial sins to prepare ourselves for the great gift of the Mass. It is important that we are on time for Mass and do not miss this prayer so that we are prepared to receive Jesus in the Eucharist. There are different options for this prayer. It can be one or both of the following:

- "I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned, in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done, and what I have failed to do.....
- Father prays for God's Mercy. Then he will say "Lord have Mercy" and we respond, "Lord have Mercy" Father says "Christ have Mercy" and we respond "Christ Have Mercy" ...

While our venial sins are forgiven at Mass, it is important to remember that our Mortal sins can ONLY be forgiven in the Sacrament of Confession. A venial sin hurts our relationship with God while a mortal sin breaks our relationship with God. While it is recommended that Catholics go to Confession once a month, it is a precept of the church (minimum requirement) that we go to Confession at least once a year. If we are in a state of mortal sin, we must first go to Confession before receiving Jesus in the Eucharist.
