

PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday form 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy Communion and Confirmation. Faith Formation This Year

The Mass is the Center of our Faith - therefore Holy Mass will be the Center of our Catechesis Program. Through the year, as we attend Mass, we will strive to grow in better understanding of Holy Mass.

Overview of the Mass:

The Mass is composed of two Parts - Liturgy of the Word and Liturgy of the Eucharist In the Liturgy of the Word, we are nourished first by the Holy Scriptures. We hear Bible readings proclaimed from the Lectern; the 1st reading, a Psalm, the 2nd reading and Gospel followed by Father's homily. The Bible is not simply about God, it is the Word OF God. So in the Lituray of the Word we encounter the words of God Himself spoken personally to each one of us. The Liturgy of the Eucharist is the 2nd part of the Mass. We are then fed with the Body of Our Lord at the table of the Eucharist. Listening to God's Words during the first part of the Mass will lead us into deeper communion with Jesus in the Eucharist. The Liturgy of the Eucharist begins when the gifts of bread and wine are brought to the altar. At the end of Mass, when the priest says "Go Forth, the Mass is ended" we are being sent forth to bring the fruits of the Eucharist to the world. The word "Mass" is actually from the Latin word Missa which means "to send forth". (from Sri, Edward A Biblical Walk through the Mass, & Mass lessons by Deirdre Nemeth)


