

PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday form 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy Communion and Confirmation. The Year July 2020 to June 2021 St. John the Evangelist Roman Catholic Church

The year of July 2020 to June 2021 was an extraordinary one. This was the year when our Churches were closed for the most part due to Covid-19 restrictions and as a parish we could only operate in a limited way.

This was the year when our old Church boiler of many years stopped working and we had to replace it with a new one.

But on a positive note, thanks to technology we were able to post whatever we wanted to communicate to you in our parish website, our Facebook page and in our weekly bulletin.

We were also able to run our religious formation program virtually and live-stream our weekend Masses and other special celebrations like First Communion and Confirmation.

During that year, 84 families participated in the Family Catechesis Program and as a result 28 children made their First Holy Communion and 23 teenagers were Confirmed. Two adults also participated in the RCIA program and during the Easter Vigil Mass they celebrated the Christian Initiation Sacraments (Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist).

During that year also, we baptized 16 infants and performed 8 anointings between homes, nursing homes and hospitals. We also celebrated 23 Masses of Christian Burial. All the weddings that were scheduled to be celebrated that year were postponed to a later date.

Because of our aging buildings, we have also repaired many small things that needed to be addressed in the Church, the Rectory and the Parish Center as listed in the bulletin of a few months ago.

One of our biggest achievements was the starting of a Spanish Mass in our parish on November 29, 2020. Right now, it is the largest attended Mass of our parish.

I thank the parish staff, the parish Finance Council, all the different parish ministries and each and every one of you for your continued support.

The Penitential Act Continued...


The Penitential Act has three forms. The longest form includes the Confiteor, which Begins, "I confess to Almighty God and to you my brothers and sisters...". In this prayer, we confess that we are sinners, acknowledging that we are at fault for our sins when we pray, "Through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault." During these words we should seek to call to mind anything we have done that has offended God or hurt others. The Church not only asks us to admit our "most grievous" fault" but also that we demonstrate our need for repentance by striking our chest three times as we say these words. We are showing ourselves and one another that repentance involves our entire person, soul and body. We are admitting that it is our fault and that we need God's Grace and the prayers of our community to avoid sinning again. 
