

PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday form 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy Communion and Confirmation. Collection envelopes will no longer be mailed to the homes, but will be made available for



Learning About the Mass continued...

<u>The Liturgy of the Word Continued –</u> <u>The Responsorial Psalm</u>

In addition to the First Reading, the Liturgy of the Word also includes the Responsorial Psalm, the Second Reading, Gospel and Homily, Profession of Faith and concludes with the Prayers of the Faithful.

After we listen to the First Reading, we sing the "Responsorial Psalm" which is also from the Old Testament. There are 150 Psalms in the bible and many of the psalms were written by King David. King David was God's chosen King of Israel.

Psalms were written as sacred hymns meant to be sung in public worship in the Temple Liturgy. Many of our church rituals in the Mass are based on synagogue customs that Jesus followed. The psalms give praise and thanksgiving to God as well as express grief or sorrow and a cry for help to God. The psalms are our hearts' response to what we hear in the First reading. If we pay attention to the First Reading, we can see how it will correspond in some way to the Responsorial psalm and more joyfully and purposefully respond by signing out the psalm at Mass.
