PARISH REGISTRATION

All families and individuals within the canonical bound areas of St. John the Evangelist are invited to register by contacting the Parish Office.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class, please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday from 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098, day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Initiation and, if married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy Communion and Confirmation. Learning About the Mass continued...

Homily

After the Gospel is read, the priest or deacon gives the Homily. Homily means "explanation" in Greek. Only an ordained priest, deacon or bishop can read the Gospel and give the homily. As successors of the apostles, these ordained ministers have the responsibility to proclaim the Gospel and pass on all that Christ taught the apostles (Mt 28:18-20). Since the gospels are the heart of the Bible, reserving the Gospel reading (and the homily) for ordained ministers reminds us how ALL the readings from the Scripture to which the gospels point "are to be read and understood under the authority of the apostolic faith".

In the early church the Word of God was not read on its own. It was always given explanation. This tradition finds its roots in Jewish custom that we see in the book of Ezra. The book of the law was not simply read to the people. The Levites would help the people understand the law (Neh 8: 7-8). Jesus himself practiced this custom. He expounded on a reading from Scripture in his hometown synagogue in Nazareth (Luke 4:10-30). We also regularly see him teaching in the synagogues through Galilee (Mark 1:21, Luke 4:15).

So, following in the footsteps of Jesus, and then the apostles, during the homily the priest will give an explanation of the readings that helps us understand God's word and how to apply it to our life so that we can live the good, faithful, moral life that God is calling us to.
