# Responsorial Psalm

After we hear the First Reading, we respond next with God's own inspired words of praise and thanksgiving from the book of Psalms. We usually sing what we call the "Responsorial Psalm" which is also from the Old Testament.

There are 150 Psalms in the bible and many of the psalms were written by King David. King David was God's chosen King of Israel.

Why do we sing the psalms? Psalms were written as sacred hymns meant to be sung in public worship in the Temple Liturgy. It may surprise some Catholics to discover that many of our church rituals in the Mass are based on synagogue customs that Jesus followed. A synagogue was a place of worship for the Israelites like churches are places of worship.

Many of the psalms were written precisely for Jewish public worship in which a community was urged to joyfully sing out the praise of God in response to hearing the Bible readings proclaimed. The psalms give praise and thanksgiving to God as well as express grief or sorrow and a cry for help to God. The psalms are our hearts' response to what we hear in the First reading. For instance, when someone says something that strikes us deeply, we cannot help but express our joyful agreement. It's as if we are saying "Yes! That's exactly right!"

This is why it's so important we pay attention to the First reading because it will correspond in some way to the Responsorial psalm. We can, therefore, more purposefully and joyfully respond by singing out the psalm at Mass. Today's Responsorial Psalm is "Blessed are the Poor in spirit, the Kingdom of heaven is theirs."


