

Great News!

The Bishop has sent word that public Masses may resume within the Diocese, following all necessary safety guidelines.

Phase I: Private Daily Masses may have up to 9 attendees so there are no more than 10 people in the building. Starting Monday, 6/8 Fr. Alphonsus is saying his daily Mass at 8:00 a.m. in the church. You are welcome to attend respecting the limit of no more than 10.

Phase II: Public Masses may resume beginning Friday, 6/12 with a capacity of no more than 30% of the church building. This means Weekend Masses will resume as of this weekend, 6/13-14, the feast of Corpus Christi! We will be using the regular weekend schedule. We are in the process of preparing the church for easy spacing and cleansing. All parishioners must follow social distancing guidelines, wear masks and use hand sanitizer.

In order to facilitate these adjustments, we would like to form a team of volunteers over the next two weeks. We will need extra volunteers such as extra greeters to help parishioners know the protocols, as well as extra ushers and people to help make the church hygienically safe for the celebration of the next Mass. Please think about being a "Back to Church" volunteer. If you would like to be a part of this group, please call and speak to the Parish Secretary, Monday through Thursday 9-2 or email the Parish Office.

The dispensation from the regular obligation to attend Mass is still in place until further notice, so those who are in the most vulnerable part of the population should not feel required to attend Mass in person though you should still find a way to keep the Lord's day by some other means.
