Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament: Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament takes place on
Thursday from 8:30 AM to 4:00 PM in the Chapel. You are invited to visit as your
schedule permits. If you wish to be a regularly scheduled adorer, please contact the Parish
Office. During Lent, Adoration takes place on Friday from 8:30 AM to 7:00 PM in the
Church.

Sacrament of Baptism: The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the First and Third
Sunday of the month at 1:30 pm. Baptisms will not be performed during Lent. An
instructional Infant Baptism Class is required for parents having their child baptized and is
recommended for godparents. For more information and to register for Pre-baptism class,
please call the Parish Office.

Sacrament of Marriage: Common Policy among the Dioceses in New Jersey recommends
preparing for your wedding at least one year in advance. Please contact the Parish Office
for more information.

Sacrament of Reconciliation: The Sacrament of Reconciliation is available every Saturday
from 4:00-4:45 pm in the Reconciliation Room of the Church or by appointment.

Sacrament of the Sick: Please contact the Parish Office if you are homebound and would
like to receive Holy Communion. In the event of an emergency, please call 732-685-1098,
day or night.

Sponsor Eligibility: Godparents/Sponsor eligibility certificates are available for registered
parishioners by calling the Parish Office. Godparents/Sponsors must be practicing
Catholics who have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist and, if
married, are in a marriage recognized by the Church.

WHOLE COMMUNITY CATECHESIS

Whole Community Catechesis is available for registered parish families with children in Grades 1-8. As the Primary Catechists of
their children, parents are prepared and supported to lead their children in faith at home. Meetings are twice a month, one for
Parents only to prepare for monthly activity lessons and one for parents and children to grow in community. Sacramental
reception years (2nd and 8th grade) have additional Sunday meetings to prepare for receiving First Reconciliation/Holy

The enclosed check received in the amount of \$9,034.00 plus an additional one in the amount of \$100 is much appreciated. This with Reverend Father DaSilva's blessing and the wholehearted response of your Council and the Parishioners of Our Lady of Fatima in Piscataway and St. John the Evangelist in Dunellen, NJ.

Our Sisters in eight centers of hope in war-torn Ukraine continue to provide the devastated local people, refugees fleeing their homes and wounded soldiers with spiritual care, food, clothing, hygienic needs and medical assistance. Whereas in Poland, our Sisters welcome mothers with children, elderly and disabled refugees who have fled across the border, opening to them their doors and hearts, offering solace, safe shelter with food, clothing, medications, and basic needs in our General House in Stara Wies and in numerous religious houses in our four Provinces of Przemysl, Krakow, Tarnow and Lodz. Our Sisters in the USA have already sent 400 parcels of first-aid items, medicines, adult and children's needs, plus needed funds to our General House for distribution to people in great need in Poland and across the border in Ukraine.

Your heartfelt contribution to this important mission of mercy is much appreciated. May God reward you with His blessings. We keep you and your loved ones in our prayers.

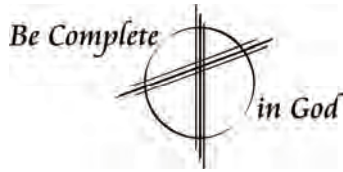
