WELCOME HOME! We are so excited to once again celebrate Holy Mass as a parish family.

Some restrictions and noticeable differences to ensure everyone's safety: All parishioners must follow **social distancing guidelines, wear masks, and use hand sanitizer.**

Seating - in order to enable safe social distancing during Mass every other pew has been closed off with blue tape. Ushers and Greeters will guide you where to sit to maintain safe social distancing.

We are working on overflow options for when we hit this limit. Unfortunately Saturday's 5:00 Mass will not have an overflow option at this time. Sunday, however, we hope to have streaming available for both the 8:30 and 10:30 Masses in the Auditorium if we need extra space.

Offertory Procession - there will not be an Offertory Procession during Mass. The gifts of bread and wine will be kept up on the altar.

Distribution of Holy Communion - Please form a single file line and maintain two pews distance between yourself and the person in front of you.

The church will be disinfected immediately following each Mass by our volunteers. All attendees are welcome to assist in the process if they are interested and able.

Mass will still be available on our website at 8:30 for those of you who do not feel comfortable attending public Mass.
