

The day is dedicated to the saints of the Church, that is, all


those who have attained heaven.

The more one does what is good, the freer one becomes.




Forming our consciences helps us avoid sin.

The Moral Formation of Conscience



A deeper look at sin

Because of our attachment to sin due to our wounded natures (the consequence of Original Sin)

we live in a constant struggle between life and death.



Mortal Sin and Venial Sin



The Church distinguishes between two types of sins: mortal sin and venial sin.



Mortal sin

When we sin mortally, we lose the supernatural life that is necessary for us to live in Heaven.



Venial sin

Venial sin is all sin in which one or more of the conditions for mortal sin are not met.


